

ANALYSIS OF ITEMS VIA AUSPEX

Item 1: Quantity of ash

Appearance: Grey powder ash, somewhat greasy. Weighs 4,021 grams. Consistent with the appearance and volume of the ash left by a deceased Kindred.

Notes: presumed to be the remains of DARREN WEST

Results of examination: Tester [REDACTED] had to be physically restrained during analysis. Upon recovered reported a sensation of burning overtaking their extremities and working it's way toward the heart. Images seen include fire, darkness, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] and a glowing ball of light (not identified necessarily as the sun). Emotions sensed were: despair, struggle, determination, resignation, fear and deja vu.

Item 2: Clothing

Appearance: One black dress shirt. One pair black slacks. One black leather belt. One pair black leather shoes. One pair men's black boxers. None have any damage or distinguishing marks.

Notes: Clothing found near ashes. No socks were located. No glove were located (see Item 4)

Results of examination: Tester [REDACTED] reported sensations of struggle, thrashing, darkness and suffocation upon inspecting the clothing. The emotions sensed were: fear and resignation. There is speculation that the sensations might be consistent with the Lasombra powers of Obtenebration, especially in conjunction with observations made regarding Item 1.

Item 11: Wallet

Appearance: One black leather wallet.

Notes: Contains: New York driver's license, Platinum Visa, State ID, NYU Library Card, \$300 cash (in 5 fifty dollar bills, 2 twenty doll bills, and 1 ten dollar bill)


Results of examination: Tester [REDACTED] reported sensations of being held and thumbed through. The emotions sensed were: depression and anxiety

Item 23: Window

Appearance: Window. 48" x 60." Opens outward. Single rod curtain with a checked green pattern.

Notes: Open window of room 356 of the Fairmont Chicago Hotel

Results of examination: Tester [REDACTED] reported sensations of wind, and saw a vision of two hands in dark maroon gloves opening the window. No strong emotions were detected.
