- Sit Bojan, Haldor, Gently, and Gorski down in a room, and make them work together re: Sabbat. (Avengers Initiative) **Update: seriously, do it. You can't handle everything yourself. You don't have to now.**
- Initiate Operation: Winter Soldier. **Done. Winter thinks it's the best plan they've ever heard - but aren't sure my faith in them is warranted. It might not be. In doing this, I place my bet, and there's a large risk inherent. In Winter, I'm placing my trust in the best of humanity - in following one's heart. I believe they'll do the right thing when the chips are down.**
